


BDS urges the boycott of companies that participate in the "Israeli apartheid".

By boycotting SodaStream, BDS caused 600 Palestinians to lose jobs with above-average wages.

BDS endangers 36,000 Palestinian jobs in the West Bank that pay up to three-times the average Palestinian wage.

If all the Jewish factories in the West Bank closed, it would negatively impact the lives of over 200,000 Palestinians.



### **BDS Anti-Peace**



BDS prohibits international events and debates with Israeli representatives and normalization projects that promote co-existence.

The Middle East Quartet (the United Nations, the United States, the European Union and Russia) supports direct dialogue in order to reach a peace agreement.

## BDS Unjust



"BDS is a strategy that allows people of conscience to play an effective role in the Palestinian struggle for justice." - BDS Guidelines

However, BDS ignores the injustice within the Palestinian authority where:

- There have not been elections since 2006
- Private and public assemblies are repeatedly broken up with excessive force
- 18 women and young girls were reportedly victims of "Honour Killings" in 2015

- Women and young girls continue to face discrimination in law and in practice, the testimony of a woman in court is worth half of a man's
- 179 reported cases of torture and ill-treatment of Palestinian detainees including children in 2015 by the Palestinian Authority in the West Bank
- 434 reported cases of Torture and ill-treatment of Palestinian detainees including children in 2015 by Hamas in Gaza

#### However:

- Palestinian children are forced to smuggle explosives
- President Abbas accumulates a net worth of over \$100 million, while the average daily wage in the West Bank is \$23 and in Gaza \$17
- Palestinians caught selling their homes to Jews are often executed
- Palestinian converts from Islam to other religions face the death penalty
