The TRUTH about WOMEN and GIRLS in PROSTITUTION





85% are women over 18 years of age

62% of these women are mothers **10%** are girls under 18 years of age

The TRUTH about MEN and BOYS in PROSTITUTION





39% of these men are fathers **0.3%** are boys under 18 years of age

The TRUTH about WOMEN and GIRLS in PROSTITUTION

57% of women entered the sex industry before 17 years of age 13 to 14

is the average age of girls entering the sex industry **11** Some girls are even 11 years old when entering the sex industry

The TRUTH about PROSTITUTION

9% of women said that another person introduced them to the sex industry 7%

of women said they entered the sex industry as a result of substance abuse

5%

of women said they entered the sex industry as a result of sexual abuse

60-80% of prostitutes experience regular sexual and physical abuse

of prostitutes have been raped while working in the sex industry

The HARM of PROSTITUTION




95% of those in prostitution experienced sexual harassment that would be legally actionable in any other job



65-95%

of those in prostitution were sexually assaulted as children

WHY do people become PROSTITUTES?

Employability

Economic Hardship

66% of the women interviewed said they started working as prostitutes to pay off debts and support children 10% said they had no other profession and no other employable skills 70% (or more) said that prostitution had failed to solve their financial problems

DO men and women in prostitution want to LEAVE?



76% of women currently involved in the sex industry shared their desire to leave

51%

of men expressed a desire to end their involvement in the sex industry

WHY can't men and women in prostitution LEAVE?



Many men and women interviewed expressed the lack of skills applicable to other industries as a barrier to leaving the sex industry



Financial debt is also often a hindrance to men and women leaving the sex industry Coercion by former employers including pimps, madams and other employees are often cited by men and women working as prostitutes as a reason not to leave

WHY can't men and women in prostitution LEAVE?



7%

of women openly stated that drug and alcohol dependence kept them from leaving the sex industry

However

this figure is probably higher amongst sex workers who are unwilling to declare their addiction

Project NGA Not Objects Anymore

Project NOA is an initiative by the Jerusalem Institute of Justice (JIJ) which aims to combat sex trafficking and prostitution in Israel.

Through education, policy development, national social media campaigns and community collaborations, Project NOA raises awareness of the harms of trafficking and prostitution. Project NOA advocates for legislative change in Israel to protect vulnerable people from objectification and exploitation.

JIJ gives legal representation to individuals who have suffered breaches of civil or human rights in the sex industry.

Project NOA promotes justice for vulnerable men, women and children and serves as a voice for the voiceless.
