ECHOES OF DENIAL: THE OCTOBER 7TH ATROCITIES AND RISING ANTISEMITISM

The October 7th attacks against Israelis were a horrific act of violence that left deep scars on the Jewish community worldwide. However, as the reality of these atrocities is denied or downplayed, antisemitic incidents have surged globally. The correlation between denialism and rising antisemitism is highlighted by presenting compelling data and emphasizing the need to protect against hate and ensure justice for the victims. Confronting this denial is essential not only for addressing current injustices but also for guaranteeing the non-recurrence of such hatred and violence in the future.

October 7, 2023

Brutal attacks on Israelis by Hamas, live-streamed by the perpetrators themselves

December 12, 2023

A nursery director in a suburb of Paris, was attacked by a man with a knife, who broke into the nursery, yelling at the director "you're Jewish, you're a Zionist. Five of us will come to rape you, cut you up like they do in Gaza"

May 31, 2024

In the United States, records show 2,619 antisemitic incidents in academic institutions between October 7, 2023 and May 31, 2024

May 8, 2025

Kanye West, an American rapper, with tens of millions of followers, released a song called "Heil Hitler", an overtly antisemitic track glorifying Nazi ideology


May 21, 2025

Israeli Embassy staffers Yaron Lischinsky and Sarah Milgrim were shot dead outside a D.C. Jewish museum; the attacker yelled, "I did it for Palestine, for Gaza."


